Preliminary results for ELC

Crude mortality is now down to an average of **8.1%** across the ELC sites.

22 out of 28 hospitals now have consultant surgeon directly involved in care, 90% of the time, at any time of day or night.

27 out of 28 hospitals have a consultant surgeon

The ELC has been shortlisted for two Patient Safety Awards for HSJ. One is for the 'Improving Surgical Services' category and the other is for Nial Quiney as 'Quality Lead of the Year.' Obviously we are very pleased but we wanted to say THANK YOU again to all members of the ELC. We could not have done this without you.

directly involved in care **80%** of the time, at any time of day or night.

12 out of 28 hospitals admit **80%** or more of all patients to ICU

And more specifically:

At Basingstoke and North Hampshire Hospitals:

- Direct consultant surgical involvement has improved from **70 to 95%**

At Darent Valley Hospital:

- Direct involvement with a consultant anaesthetist has improved from **70 to 90%**

- ICU admission rate has improved from **62% to a massive 90%!**

- Crude mortality rate here has fallen from **13.8% to 6.3%**

At Cheltenham Hospital:

- Direct consultant surgeon involvement in laparotomy cases has increased from **84% to 100%**

- ICU admission rate has improved from **57% to 82%**

- Patients who require a Category 1 operation (< 2 hours) has increased from **65% to 100%**

This is truly AMAZING figures and we know that behind each change is a dedicated clinician and team working really really hard.
